10:00 am: Ron Meisels – Where are we in the 40 year cycle? And CSTA: Past, Present and Future!

Ron Meisels, Founder and President of Phases & Cycles Inc. is one of North America's most successful technical analysts with over 40 years of stock market experience. He specializes in the independent research of Canadian and U.S. securities using Behavior Analysis. Institutions ranked him among the top three technical analysts for six consecutive years (Brendan Wood Survey).

Ron has been publishing the technically oriented Phases & Cycles® reports since 1970. He has a distinguished track record in anticipating stock market moves, as illustrated by his famous "10,000 in 2000" prediction in January 1995 (based on his discovery of the 40-year cycle) when the DJIA was at 3800

Ron is a co-writer of a weekly column in the Globe and Mail ("What the charts say"); he is a frequent guest on Business News Network (BNN) and is frequently quoted in major financial media such as the Globe & Mail, The National Post, Barron's, Les Affaires, Bloomberg, Canadian Press, Reuters, etc.

Mr. Meisels is also the Founder and first President of the Canadian Society of Technical Analysts (CSTA), and founding Secretary and past Director of the International Federation of Technical Analysts (IFTA). He was the first Canadian recipient of the A. J. Frost Award for outstanding contribution to the development of Technical Analysis and developed the "Meisels Index", an overbought/oversold indicator based on daily closings. It is featured on the Metastock system.

12:00 pm – Martin Pring

Martin Pring is one of the most prominent names in the industry. A master technical analyst and educator extraordinaire, he is the award-winning author of numerous books on Technical Analysis, including *Introduction to Technical Analysis* and *Technical Analysis Explained*. The latter is now used by several international technical societies for training and is one of the three core books for Level 1 CMT certification with the Market Technicians Association. Translated into over 10 languages, the book is, as quoted by Forbes, "*widely regarded as the standard work for this generation of chartists*". According to Futures Magazine, "*it is one of the best books on*

technical analysis to come out since Edwards & Magee's classic text in 1948...belongs on the shelf of every serious trader and technical analyst". As a leader in the global investment community and a highly-sought after speaker worldwide, Martin's articles have been featured in Barron's and he has been quoted in *The Weall Street Journal*, *International Herald Tribune*, *The New York Post* and more.

First entering the financial industry in 1969, Martin founded Pring Research in 1981 and began providing research for financial institutions and individual investors around the world. Over the past 34 years, Martin's research has led to the development of reliable financial and economic indicators for timely and effective forecasting. His personal barometers for the Bond, Equity and Commodities markets have identified major turning points since the 1950's on a timely basis and have outperformed the common buy/hold approach by a wide margin.

For many years, Martin's primary interest has been educating students of technical analysis in the basic and finer points of this art. He enjoys mentoring students of technical analysis from the college level to professional investors already in the field, sharing the wealth of knowledge that he has gained throughout his lengthy career in the industry. Some of his indicators include the following: Sequential®, Combo®, Setup®, Setup Trend (TDST)®, Countdown®, Range Expansion Index™, D-Wave®, TD Lines™, Differential™ and Camouflage®.

DeMark Analytics* LLC provides DeMark's suite of market-timing software to data vendors, such as Bloomberg, CQG, and Thomson Reuters. DeMark served as special advisor to Leon Cooperman, a \$5 billion hedge fund manager. He partnered with Chicago Board of Trade Treasury Bond legend Charlie DiFrancesca ("Charlie D"). Tom DeMark worked with multibillion dollar fund manager Van Hoisington. Tom was executive vice president of Tudor (Paul Tudor Jones), a multibillion dollar hedge fund.
